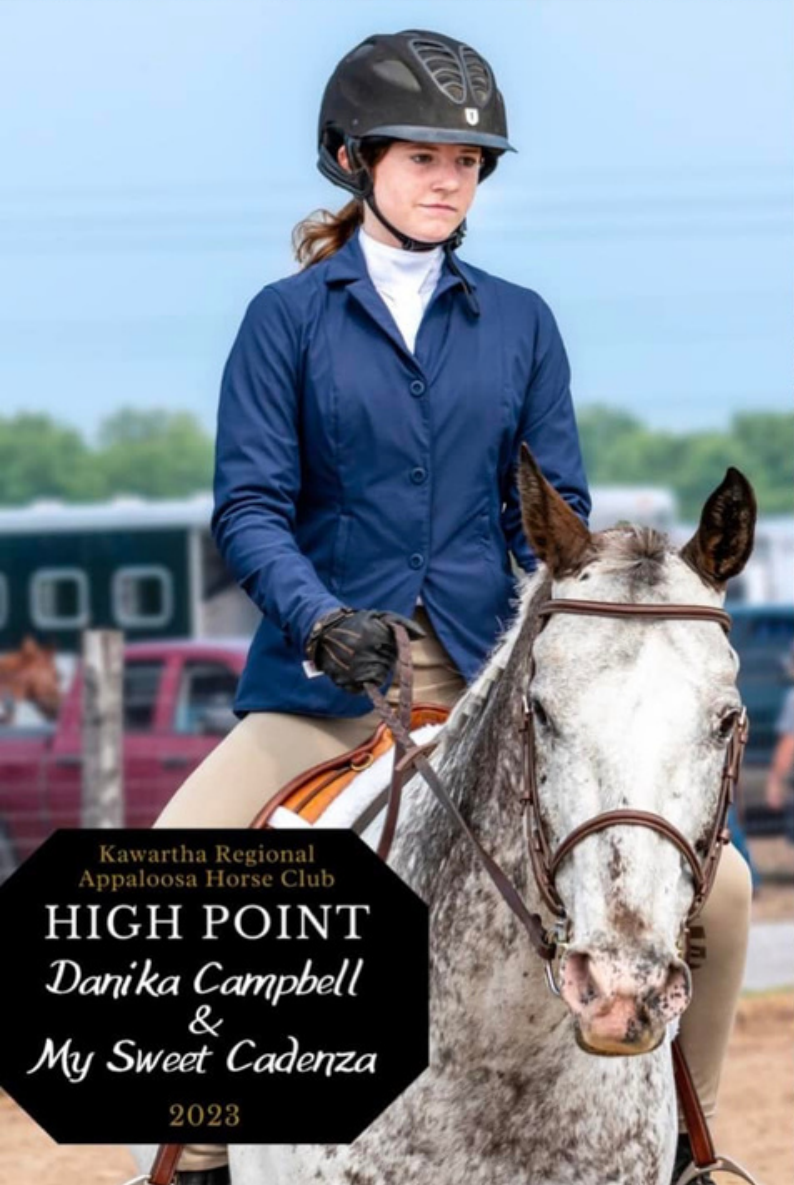

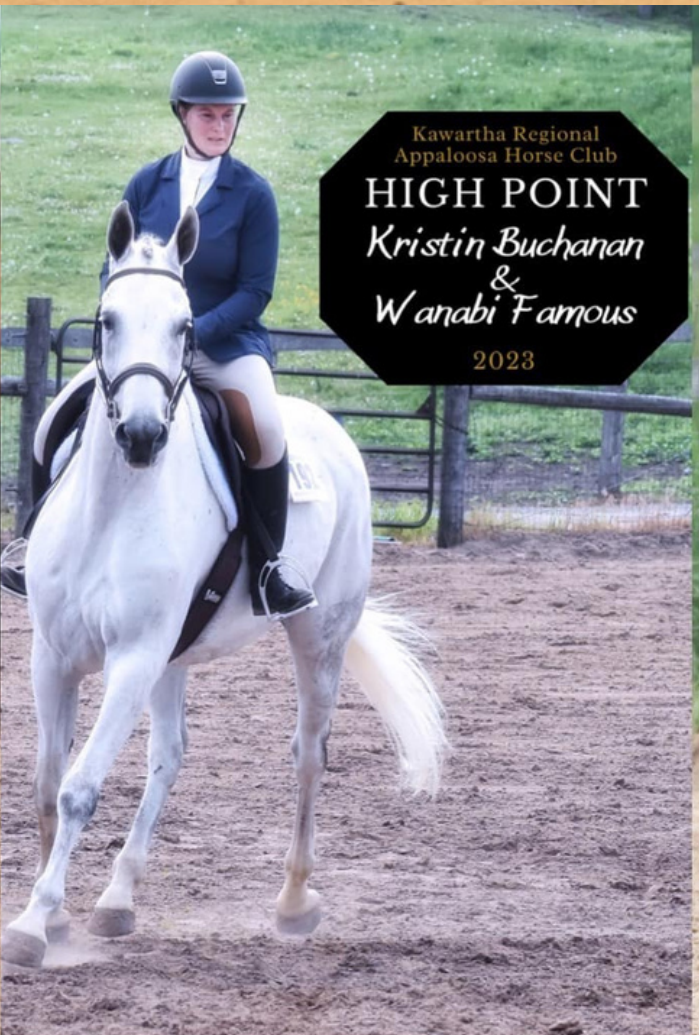

DIRECTOR - REAGAN SLUISKES

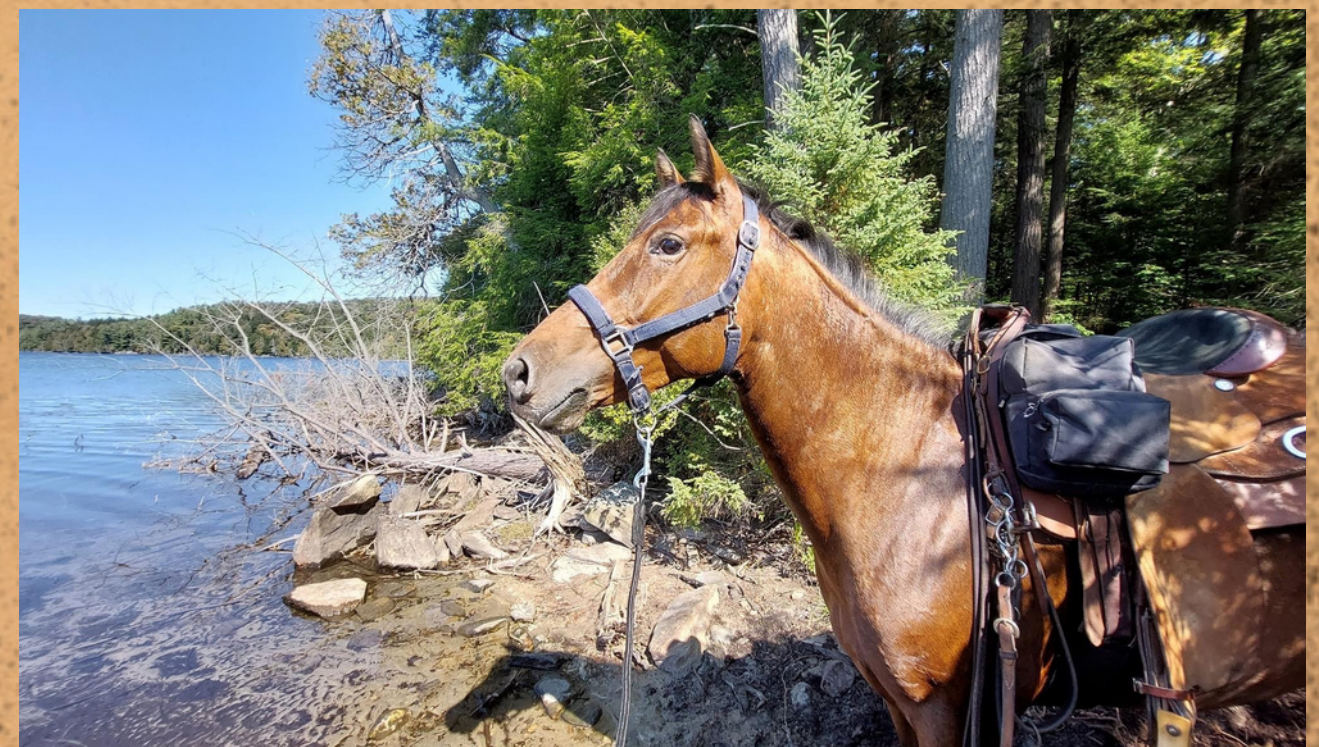
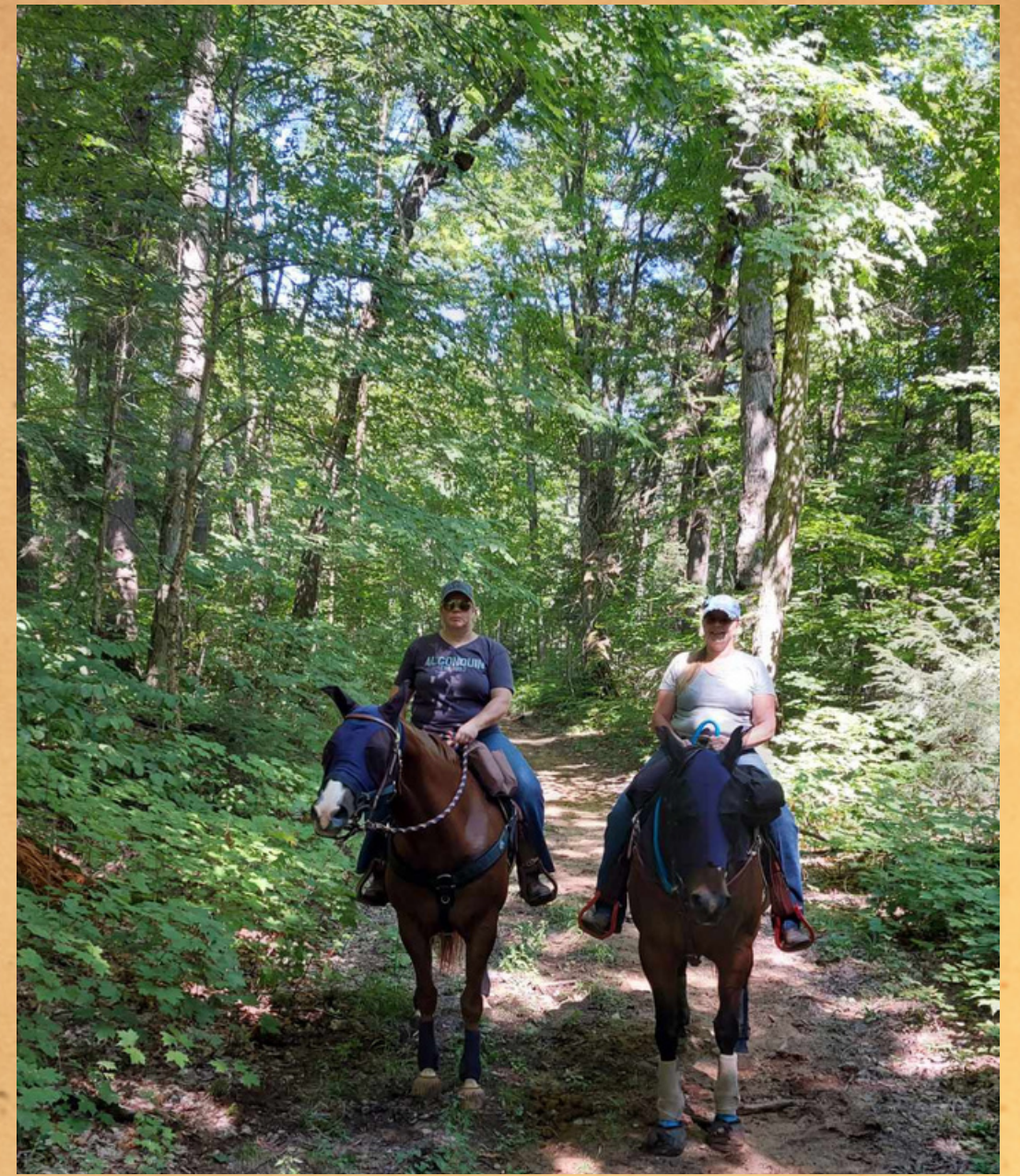


Favourite Classes: Horsemanship & Trail

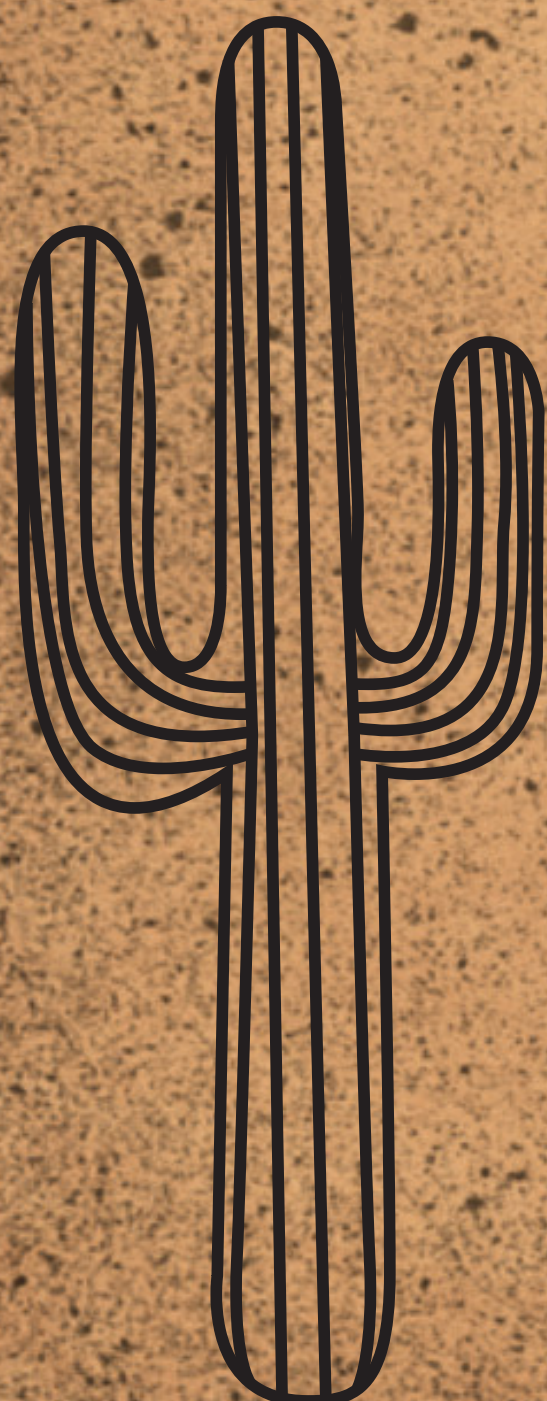
